Directions and Parking

Custom Chocolate is on the NW corner of Lexington and Larpenteur in Roseville. Go around to the back of the building and enter through the alley. Members can park in the open parking area across the drive from Custom Chocolate's alley door.

Going north on Lexington from Larpenteur, get in the left lane and take the very first left turn (on the south side of Arthur's Jewelers). Go straight down the alley. If you go straight down the alley, you are heading right to the Custom Chocolate dock door. The large sign above the dock door will say "Custom Chocolate." A smaller door will read "Office." Parking is to the right. Our retail store is among the stores on the front of the strip mall.
